



DIRECTIONS TO COOLAMON STATION FROM THE NORTH

(ie: from Brisbane, Gold Coast & the Tweed)

- Take the Cabarita Beach/Bogangar exit off the M1, go through roundabout onto **Clothiers Creek Road** towards Cabarita Beach
- Follow Clothiers Creek Road for 800 metres (1 min) and turn right into **Watty Bishop Road**
- Follow Watty Bishop Road (running parallel to the M1) for 2.6kms (2 mins) until the T-intersection – turn right onto **Round Mountain Road** (you will now be heading West over the M1 overpass)
- Follow Round Mountain Road for 3.2 kms (approx. 5 minutes). Note: This road will turn to unsealed (dirt) road after approximately 2.2 kms (2 mins). It is a beautiful, scenic narrow road that will turn back into bitumen after 1km.
- The road will turn back into bitumen and you will come to T-intersection. Turn right here onto **Reserve Creek Road** towards Murwillumbah.
- Follow for 2kms (2 mins) and you will come to **Palmvale Road** on your left hand side
- Turn left into **Palmvale Road** and follow for 2.5kms (4 mins)
- You will see a white railing fence, cow letterbox with “**Coolamon Station**” sign on the fence. **245 Palmvale Road Palmvale!** Welcome you’re here!! Come on in straight down the driveway (check out the cows, calves & Harry the horse in the paddock on the right as you come in) go past the stables – you will see the Woolshed & carpark ahead on your left hand side – can’t miss it!!

.... you made it!! Welcome to your amazing farm experience!

No you’re not lost! 😊😊😊

*Driving time from the M1 Cabarita Beach/Bogangar exit to Coolamon Station is approximately **13 mins** (10kms) depending on road conditions. We are a rural property hidden away in a gorgeous, secluded pocket of the Tweed Valley – that’s what makes us so incredibly special! You may feel like you are a million miles from anywhere but you are only 12 mins from the M1, and only 14 mins from the gorgeous Cabarita Beach!
